Consecration Agreement

Every year Rock Springs YP Camp has been a time of enjoying the riches of Christ in an atmosphere of pleasant seeking of the Lord. We have learned that this kind of corporate experience of the Spirit comes out of much prayer, the release of our Lord's Word, the exercise of the spirit, definite times alone with God in prayer, and the firm restriction of the flesh. We expect, therefore, that each young person would spend some time with his or her parents to present themselves to the Lord for the Rock Springs Truth School Fall Refresher. We do not recommend coming to the Rock Springs in a kind of light social way. This would not be profitable for you or for others. Parents who are involved in the weekend at Rock Springs should also spend some definite time to consecrate this time in a serious way to the Lord. We hope every worker and every home would be in one accord for the spirit and goal of this time.

Rock Springs Regulations

1. No behavior that distracts you or others from the goal of this weekend will be tolerated. This especially applies to boy-girl relationships. No private contact between young brothers and sisters, including phone calls and text messaging.
2. A respectful and cooperative attitude toward both college and adult workers should be maintained at all times.
3. The time at Rock Springs will have a very definite schedule. We expect your willing participation in all activities.
4. Absolutely no magazines, books, radios, CD's, MP3's, electronic games, dice, or cards will be allowed.
5. Cell phones may be brought for the purpose of contact with parents, but will be kept and regulated by the workers. No text messaging is allowed at any time.
6. No inappropriate logos, short shorts, or tank tops are allowed.
