PHILIPPIANS 1:1 – 3:8

Week March 19–24

Mon, March 19th

Philippians 1:1-2 Paul and Timothy, slaves of Christ Jesus, to all the saints in Christ Jesus who are in Philippi, with the overseers and deacons: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Tue, Mar 20th

Philippians 1:3-4 I thank my God upon all my remembrance of you, Always in my every petition on behalf of you all, making my petition with joy,

Wed, Mar 21st

Philippians 1:5-6 For you fellowship unto the furtherance of the gospel from the first day until now, Being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun in you a good work will complete it until the day of Christ Jesus;

Thu, Mar 22nd

Philippians 1:7-8 Even as it is right for me to think this concerning you all because you have me in your heart, since both in my bonds and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel you are all fellow partakers with me of grace. For God is my witness how I long after you all in the inward parts of Christ Jesus.

Fri, Mar 23rd

Philippians 1:9-10 And this I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in full knowledge and all discernment, So that you may approve by testing the things which differ and are more excellent, that you may be pure and without offense unto the day of Christ,

Sat, Mar 24th

Philippians 1:11-12 Being filled with the fruit of righteousness, which is through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God. Now I want you to know, brothers, that the things concerning me have turned out rather to the advancement of the gospel,

Week March 25-31

LD, Mar 25th

Philippians 1:13-14 So that my bonds have become manifest as being in Christ among the whole Praetorian guard and to all the rest. And most of the brothers, being confident in the Lord because of my bonds, are more exceedingly bold to speak the word of God without fear.

Mon, Mar 26th

Philippians 1:15-16 Some preach Christ even because of envy and strife, and some also because of good will, These out of love, knowing that I am set for the defense of the gospel.

Tue, Mar 27th

Philippians 1:17-18 But the others announce Christ out of selfish ambition, not purely, thinking to raise up affliction in my bonds. What then? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truthfulness, Christ is announced; and in this I rejoice; yes, and I will rejoice;

Wed, Mar 28th

Philippians 1:19-20 For I know that for me this will turn out to salvation through your petition and the bountiful supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ, According to my earnest expectation and hope that in nothing I will be put to shame, but with all boldness, as always, even now Christ will be magnified in my body, whether through life or through death.

Thu, Mar 29th

Philippians 1:21-22 For me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. But If I am to live in the flesh, if this to me is fruit for my work, then I do not know what I will choose.

Fri, Mar 30th

Philippians 1:23-24 But I am constrained between the two, having the desire to depart and be with Christ, for this is far better; But to remain in the flesh is more necessary for your sake.

Sat, Mar 31st

Philippians 1:25-26 And being confident of this, I know that I will remain and continue with you all for your progress and joy of the faith, That your boast may abound in Christ Jesus in me through my coming again to you.

Week April 1-7

LD, April 1st

Philippians 1:27-28 Only, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ, that whether coming and seeing you or being absent, I may hear of the things concerning you, that you stand firm in one spirit, with one soul striving together along with the faith of the gospel, And in nothing being frightened by the opposers, which is to them a proof of their destruction, but of your salvation, and that from God;

Mon, Apr 2nd

Philippians 1:29-30 Because to you it has been graciously granted on behalf of Christ not only to believe into Him but also to suffer on His behalf, Having the same struggle which you saw in me and now hear to be in me.

Tue, Apr 3rd

Philippians 2:1-2 If there is therefore any encouragement in Christ, if any consolation of love, if any fellowship of spirit, if any tenderheartedness and compassions, Make my joy full, that you think the same thing, having the same love, joined in soul thinking the one thing,

Wed, Apr 4th

Philippians 2:3-4 Doing nothing by way of selfish ambition nor by way of vainglory, but in lowliness of mind considering one another more excellent than yourselves; Not regarding each his own virtues, but each the virtues of others also.

Thu, Apr 5th

Philippians 2:5-6 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus, Who existing in the form of God, did not consider being equal with God a treasure to be grasped,

Fri, Apr 6th

Philippians 2:7-8 But emptied Himself, taking the form of a slave, becoming in the likeness of men; And being found in fashion as a man, He humbled Himself, becoming obedient even unto death, and that the death of a cross.

Sat, Apr 7th

Philippians 2:9-10 Therefore also God highly exalted Him and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, That in the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth,

Week Apr 8-14

LD, Apr 8th

Philippians 2:11-12 And every tongue should openly confess that Jesus Christ is Lord to the glory of God the Father. So then, my beloved, even as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only but now much rather in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling;

Mon, Apr 9th

Philippians 2:13-14 For it is God who operates in you both the willing and the working for His good pleasure. Do all things without murmurings and reasonings

Tue, Apr 10th

Philippians 2:15-16 That you may be blameless and guileless, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and perverted generation, among whom you shine as luminaries in the world, Holding forth the word of life, so that I may have a boast in the day of Christ that I did not run in vain nor labor in vain.

Wed, Apr 11th

Philippians 2:17-18 But even if I am being poured out as a drink offering upon the sacrifice and service of your faith, I rejoice, and I rejoice together with you all. And in like manner you also rejoice, and you rejoice together with me.

Thu, Apr 12th

Philippians 2:19-20 But I hope in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy to you shortly, that I also may be encouraged by knowing the things concerning you. For I have no one like-souled who will genuinely care for what concerns you;

Fri, Apr 13th

Philippians 2:21-22 For all seek their own things, not the things of Christ Jesus. But you know his approvedness, that as a child with a father he has served with me unto the gospel.

Sat, Apr 14th

Philippians 2:23-24 Him therefore I hope to send immediately, as soon as I see how things go with me. But I trust in the Lord that I myself also will come shortly.

Week April 15-21

LD, Apr 15th

Philippians 2:25-26 But I considered it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my brother and fellow worker and fellow soldier, and your apostle and minister to my need, Since he longed after you all and was greatly distressed because you heard that he had become sick;

Mon, Apr 16th

Philippians 2:27-28 For indeed he had become sick, near to death, but God had mercy on him, and not on him only but also on me that I might not have sorrow upon sorrow. I have sent him therefore the more eagerly, so that when you see him again, you may rejoice and I may be less sorrowful.

Tue, Apr 17th

Philippians 2:29-30 Receive him therefore in the Lord with all joy, and hold such in honor, Because for the work of Christ he drew near unto death, risking his life, that he might fill up your lack of service toward me.

Wed, Apr 18th

Philippians 3:1-2 Finally, my brothers, rejoice in the Lord. To write the same things to you, for me it is not irksome, but for you it is safe. Beware of the dogs, beware of the evil workers, beware of the concision.

Thu, Apr 19th

Philippians 3:3-4 For we are the circumcision, the ones who serve by the Spirit of God and boast in Christ Jesus and have no confidence in the flesh, Though I myself have something to be confident of in the flesh as well. If any other man thinks that he has confidence in the flesh, I more:

Fri, Apr 20th

Philippians 3:5-6 Circumcised the eighth day; of the race of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew born of Hebrews; as to the law, a Pharisee; As to zeal, persecuting the church; as to the righteousness which is in the law, become blameless.

Sat, Apr 21st

Philippians 3:7-8 But what things were gains to me, these I have counted as loss on account of Christ. But moreover I also count all things to be loss on account of the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, on account of whom I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as refuse that I may gain Christ
